Sustainable Supply Chain | Definition

A sustainable supply chain is a system of interconnected businesses that work together to ensure that the production, transportation, and distribution of goods and services are done in a way that minimizes negative environmental and social impacts while promoting economic growth and development.

Consumers are now more aware of the negative environmental and social impacts of the products they purchase and are increasingly demanding products that are produced sustainably.

This has led businesses to focus on sustainable supply chain management as a means of meeting consumer demand and minimizing negative impacts.



Sustainable Supply Chain | Benefits



Sustainable supply chain management offers several benefits to businesses.



Reduce costs by promoting more efficient use of resources.





Enhance brand reputation by demonstrating a commitment to sustainability.

Reduce supply chain risks by promoting greater transparency and accountability.







Environmental Sustainability: This involves reducing the environmental impact of the supply chain by reducing greenhouse gas emissions, minimizing waste, and promoting the use of renewable energy.



Social Sustainability: This involves promoting fair labor practices, promoting diversity and inclusion, and ensuring the health and safety of workers.



Economic Sustainability: This involves promoting economic growth and development while ensuring that the benefits of economic activity are shared broadly throughout society.



Sustainable Supply Chain | Strategies



Businesses can use several strategies to promote sustainable supply chain management.



Supplier Engagement: This involves working closely with suppliers to promote sustainable practices throughout the supply chain.



Life Cycle Assessment: This involves assessing the environmental impact of products throughout their entire life cycle, from production to disposal.



Lean Manufacturing: This involves minimizing waste and maximizing efficiency throughout the manufacturing process.



Collaboration: This involves working collaboratively with other businesses, governments, and civil society organizations to promote sustainable supply chain management.







Internal Audit's Role | Education & Training





Gain a deep understanding of the organization's supply chain structure, processes, and practices.



Staying up to date with emerging sustainability trends, regulations, and best practices in supply chain management.



Providing training and workshops to procurement staff, leadership and other members on sustainable procurement practices.



Acting as a catalyst for change by advocating for integration of sustainable supply chain practices into organization's strategic goals.



Internal Audit's Role | Assurance Roles





Auditing supplier performance against sustainability criteria, such as environmental impact, labor practices, and ethical sourcing.



Assessing environmental, social & governance supply chain risks and auditing procurement practices to identify areas for sustainability integration.



Providing recommendations on improving supply chain sustainability, such as adopting eco-friendly packaging, reducing waste etc.



Monitoring and reporting on the organization's sustainable procurement progress / KPIs to leadership and stakeholders.



Internal Audit's Role | Consulting Roles





Supporting the procurement team in developing sustainable procurement policies and guidelines.






Suggesting collaboration opportunities with suppliers to improve sustainability practices, such as sharing best practices or engaging in joint initiatives.
